



Churchill	58°46'09'' N	Continental (Dfc) Subarctic climate. Long very cold winter and short cool summer.	Boreal moist forest

Buenos Aires	34°36'12'' S	Temperate (Cfa) Humid subtropical climate. Hot, humid summer. Mild winter.	Warm temperate dry forest
