A few logistical bits...


- Fleeces for outdoors only

Hear your child reading aloud daily.

- Ask them to summarise, recall, explain, compare, give their opinion.
- What, where, when , how, why

Reluctant reader:

- I read a page, you read one.
- Read to a younger sibling, grand parents, a pet!
- Don't pick up on every mistake only ask 1 question
- Re-read a sentence/page 2 or 3 times to build fluency and...
- Praise, praise, praise the effort and progress.

Maths – Times tables

- **Year 3:** X 2, 3, 4, 5, 8, 10
- Year 4: National assessment on all times tables
- Multiplication needed from term 2 till July START NOW

- Daily on Garage
- Monthly on Gig
- Individual account (don't let anyone else on)

Maths - Time

- By end Year 2: o'clock, half past, quarter past/to, 5 min
- Year 3:
 - telling the time to the minute
 - seconds
 - Digital clocks with AM and PM

Maths - Money

Handle coins and notes to:

- Recognise them
- Know how to make £1
- Add them
- Understand the idea of change
- £ 2 and 50 p rather than £2.50



Homework

- Daily:
 - Reading
 - Spellings test on Wednesday issued 1 week ahead.
 - TT Rock Stars
- Weekly
 - Reading comprehension
- Set on Teams and to be submitted on Teams.
